“¿A QUIÉN ESTÁS SIGUIENDO?”

29no Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Isaías 45,6: “Yo soy el Señor, no hay otro.” En el Evangelio de hoy, los fariseos quieren tenderle una trampa a Jesús, cuestionándolo que si es legítimo pagar impuestos al Cesar. Estos están esperando que El caiga usando testimonios falsos y difamatorios en contra de la ley Judía y la ley política de aquellos tiempos. Claro que, Jesús no cae en la trampa. Su respuesta fue: “Entonces páguenle al Cesar lo que es del Cesar y a Dios lo que es de Dios.” El practicante del Stewardship se da cuenta que todo le pertenece a Dios, el creador de todas las cosas. Jesús sabe esto también. De todas maneras, El también sabe que Dios tiene muy poco uso para los impuestos en dólares; lo que Él quiere de nosotros, es un corazón lleno de amor, el cual es mucho más valioso. Su respuesta fue más bien dirigida al mandamiento en contra de la idolatría y es un llamado a seguir a Dios. De hecho, Su respuesta suena mucho como nuestro lema del Stewardship: “A quien estas siguiendo.”

29º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

“Dios sigue actuando en la historia. El Espíritu Santo sigue moviendo los corazones de los cristianos como en la primera comunidad cristiana de Tesalónica; la comunidad era ejemplar por su fe, su caridad y esperanza. Si seguimos su ejemplo seremos capaces en la actualidad de lograr un equilibrio entre Dios y el César. Entre Dios y los impuestos que cada año debemos pagar al gobierno. Por un decir, la invitación de Dios ante todo esto es que la política no es lo importante sino que dentro de ella se respete al ser humano y su dignidad. Balance entre el ser humano y lo divino es lo que Jesús en el Evangelio nos enseña. Los fariseos no perdían el tiempo en poner a prueba a Jesús, y comprometerlo con sus respuestas. Unidos con unos partidarios de Herodes, inician la conversación buscando como acusarlo y deshacerse de él lo antes posible. Sus palabras de alabanza al inicio de las preguntas se convierten en trampa y ponen a prueba la honradez de Jesús. “Maestro, sabemos que eres sincero y enseñas con verdad el camino de Dios, y que nada te arredra, porque no buscas el favor de nadie. Dínos, pues, qué piensas”. La pregunta: “¿Es lícito o no pagar el tributo al César?” Jesús es acertado en su respuesta, dando una salida brillante. ¡Denuncia su hipocresía! La ambición de los dirigentes, su amor al dinero, facilita el dominio de los romanos sobre los pobres de Israel, por lo tanto, esto impide que den un verdadero culto a Dios, alejándose de la honestidad y solidaridad con los que más sufren. ¿Crees que sucede esto ahora? ¿Dónde lo identificas? ¿Qué es lo que hay que devolver a Dios?

29th Sunday in Ordinary Time

“Then repay to Caesar what belongs to Caesar and to God what belongs to God.” Jesus had a brilliant way of navigating tricky situations. In today's Gospel, the Pharisees “plotted how they might entrap Jesus in speech.” But he outwitted them, as usual. They wanted to catch him being a political rebel; they expected him to suggest that paying taxes to Caesar was unnecessary or even unjust. But instead, he shifted the focus. He emphasized the importance of fulfilling our civic responsibilities but also the necessity of giving to God what we owe him. So, how do we know what we should “repay” to God? Well, Jesus' response to the Pharisees gives us our answer. He looked at the Roman coin that bore the image of Caesar on it. Then he concluded that the coin belonged to Caesar because it was made in his likeness. Now, what bears the image of God? What is made in his likeness? We are! “God created man in his image; in the divine image he created him; male and female he created them” (Gn 1:27). If the coin belonged to Caesar, we belong to God. We repay God by giving him ourselves! This self-giving is what the Second Vatican Council called “the obedience of faith.” Through this spiritual obedience, we freely commit ourselves to God, “offering the full submission of intellect and will to God” (Dei Verbum #5). Jesus is calling us today to use our will to choose to follow God. Indeed, the one thing we can give God in return for the gift of life is our will. He gave us the freedom to love him or not. And while the choice is always ours, today Jesus encourages us to make the right decision by giving God what is really his: ourselves!

"WHO ARE YOU FOLLOWING?"

29th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Is 45:1, 4-6, 1 Thes 1:1-5b, Mt 22:15-21

Isaiah 45:6 "I am the LORD, there is no other." In today's Gospel, the Pharisees try to trap Jesus by asking if it lawful to pay taxes to Caesar. They are hoping to snare Him using false flattery and either the Jewish law or the political law of the day. Of course, Jesus doesn't fall into the trap. His response: "Then repay to Caesar what is Caesar's, and to God what is God's." The steward realizes that everything belongs to God, the creator of all things. Jesus knows this, too. However, He also knows that God has little use for tax dollars...what HE wants from us -- our whole-hearted love -- is much more valuable. His response is aimed at the commandment against idolatry, and is a call to follow God. In fact, His response sounds very much like our Stewardship Theme, "Who are you following?"


