"¿A Quién estás Siguiendo?" Quinto Domingo en el Tiempo Ordinario Trabajo 7:1-4, 6-7/1 Cor 9:16-19, 22-23/ MK 1:29-39

En la primera lectura de hoy, vemos a Job en las profundidades de su miseria. Se refiere a la vida como "monotonía" y ve sus días deslizándose por en un borrón, "más rápido que un transbordador de tejedor." aquí vemos a un hombre que lo ha perdido todo, incluyendo su esperanza; vemos a un hombre que simplemente está esperando para morir. ¿Cuántos de nosotros nos hemos permitido alcanzar este punto de desesperación? ¿hemos olvidado nuestras vocaciones? ¿hemos permitido que nuestros apegos al mundo nos cegaran de nuestro mayor propósito? En estos momentos, debemos recurrir a Jesús con la fe de los primeros discípulos. Cuando le dijeron a Jesús acerca de la suegra de Simón, "se acercó, agarró su mano y la ayudó a levantarse. Entonces la fiebre la dejó y ella esperó en ellos." "la auto-compasión de Job es comprensible, pero no es aceptable. El mayordomo debe permanecer erguido y recurrir a Jesús con la esperanza de la fuerza, la curación y el propósito.

5º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

¡Tómame Señor de la mano y levántame! Te necesito, cúrame de mis enfermedades y dolencias, deja que me apiñe dentro de tu corazón. 5th Sunday in Ordinary Time

For most of us, the dynamic between prayer and action is imperfect. Breakfast needs to be made and the kids dressed. Work demands our energy and additional responsibilities fill our evenings and weekends. Then there's the football game or a new TV series to stream. After all, don't we need to relax? We're all busy. But just imagine Jesus' situation in today's Gospel. He heals Peter's mother-in-law, drives out demons, and cures diseases late into the night. With very little sleep, he arises before dawn to capture some peace and quiet, only to find "those who were with him pursued him." How often do we feel pursued by the harried commitments, even when we try to seek rest? Perhaps we can learn something from the response of Jesus.

Jesus models two key things: the essential nature of prayer and the essential call of vocation. "He went off to a deserted place, where he prayed." Despite inevitable exhaustion, Jesus prioritizes time with the Father. We might not have easy access to deserts and mountaintops, but today's Gospel challenges us to take intentional time set apart for God. We can designate a "prayer chair" in a corner of our home or leave a little earlier to pick our children up from school so we can snatch time in a nearby chapel. We can pray the rosary on our commute or take the dog for a long walk in silence.

However, when the Apostles arrive, Jesus doesn't linger over-long in the deserted place or make an excuse for why he can't return with his friends. Jesus is true to his calling. He continues on in his state of life, serving the people nearest to him. Like Jesus, we are invited to set intentional time for communion with God so that we can be refreshed and empowered for our communion with others.

"Who are you following?" Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time Job 7: 1-4, 6-7 / 1 Cor 9: 16-19, 22-23 / Mk 1: 29-39

In today's first reading, we see Job in the depths of his misery. He refers to life as "drudgery" and sees his days slipping by in a blur, "swifter than a weaver's shuttle." Here we see a man who has lost everything, including his hope; we see a man who is simply waiting to die. How many of us have allowed ourselves to reach this point of desperation? Have we forgotten our vocations? Have we allowed our attachments to the world to blind us from our greater purpose? In these moments, we must turn to Jesus with the faith of the first disciples. When they told Jesus about Simon's mother-in-law, "He approached, grasped her hand, and helped her up. Then the fever left her and she waited on them." Job's self-pity is understandable, but it is not acceptable. The steward must remain upright and turn to Jesus with the hope of strength, healing, and purpose.
