1 SM 26: 2, 7-9, 12-13, 22-23/1
COR 15: 45-49 / LK 6: 27-38

Some people struggle with a sense of joy." Once again Jesus is challenging us to be good stewards and to be fully alive. Is our giving of self done out of gratitude, or is it in the expectation of something in return? Do we hold it over Jesus' head in our own times of need? Jesus says love your enemies and lend expecting nothing back...for He Himself is kind to the ungrateful and the wicked (that's us). Take, for example, David in today's first reading. David had the opportunity to kill Saul and declare victory in a violent and arrogant way. Instead, he took the king's spear, declaring victory in a much more subtle and merciful way. He declared that, "The LORD will reward each man for his justice and faithfulness." David understands that he is cooperating with God's plans, and is a faithful steward. Likewise, Luke 6:38 says, "For the measure with which you measure will in return be measured out to you." If we are to be deserving of abundant mercy, then we are to give mercy abundantly. We are being called to give generously, and to the point of vulnerability.

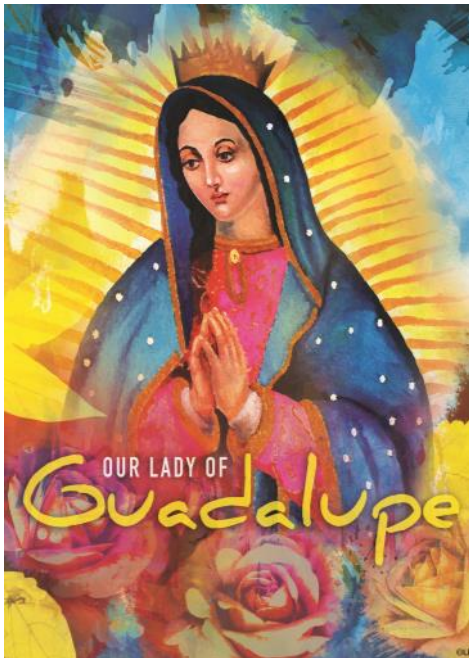

“Plenamente Vivos Como Discípulos Misioneros”

Una vez más Jesús nos reta a ser buenos practicantes del Stewardship y a estar plenamente vivos. ¿Es el dar, desinteresadamente y debido a nuestra gratitud o acaso estamos esperando algo a cambio? ¿Se lo dejamos a Dios solamente cuando necesitamos algo? Jesús dice que amemos a nuestros enemigos y que demos sin esperar nada de regreso, porque El mismo es bueno con el desagradecido y el malvado (así somos nosotros). Como ejemplo esta David, el de la primera lectura. David tuvo la oportunidad de matar a Saúl y declarar victoria de una forma violenta y arrogante; en cambio, el tomo la lanza del rey declarando victoria de una forma más sutil y misericordiosa. El declaró que, “El Señor recompensara a cada hombre por su justicia y su fidelidad.” David entiende que el está cooperando con los planes de Dios y que es fiel practicante del Stewardship. Así mismo, Lucas 6,38 dice, “con la vara que mides serás medido”. Si nosotros somos merecedores de misericordia abundante, entonces debemos de dar misericordia abundante. Estamos llamados a dar generosamente al punto de la vulnerabilidad.

7º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Las lecturas del domingo pasado nos hablaban de las Bienaventuranzas como una forma de vida. Ahora, la Liturgia nos pone en la difícil situación de amar a nuestros enemigos. Situación que compromete y responsabiliza ha ambas partes, el que persigue y el que perdona. En la primera lectura se puede escuchar claramente con el comportamiento de David hacia el Rey Saúl de cómo se ama al enemigo. En el Evangelio no se debe de perder de vista el fin de la enseñanza del Señor Jesús, “¿?amen a sus enemigos, hagan el bien a los que los odian, bendigan a los que los maldicen, rueguen por los que los maltratan. Al que te golpea en una mejilla, preséntale también la otra. Al que te arrebata el manto, entrégale también el vestido. Da al que te pide, y al que te quita lo tuyo, no se lo reclames.” (Lucas 6:27 -30). Lo que sigue del Evangelio es una perfecta catequesis de la misericordia y compasión de Dios hacia todo el que escucha su Palabra y la pone en práctica. La vida de todo bautizado debe estar colmada de esa gran bondad que Jesús mostraba a su pueblo en su tiempo y ahora en este tiempo. Compromiso de amor que implica no juzgar a la ligera a los que nos rodean; de perdonar a los que nos hacen mal en un proceso de vida. Para lograr ese proceso les invito a reflexionar en las siguientes preguntas: ¿Quiénes son hoy en día los enemigos de la familia y la sociedad? ¿Quiénes persiguen a los jóvenes en su lucha para cumplir sus sueños? ¿Quiénes promueven la justicia y la paz en la familia y la sociedad? La respuesta te implica a ti.
