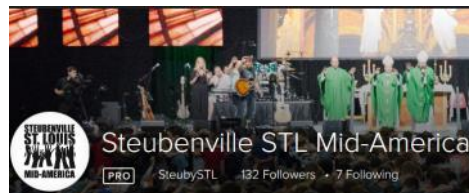

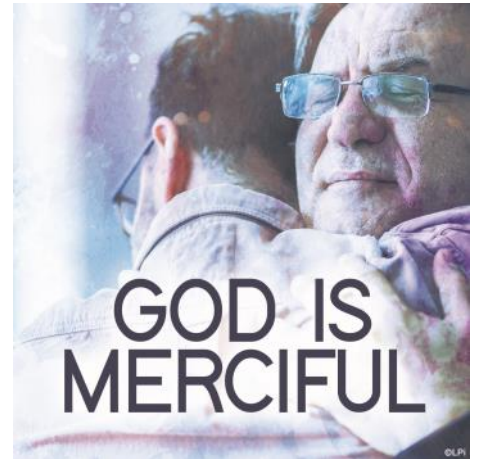

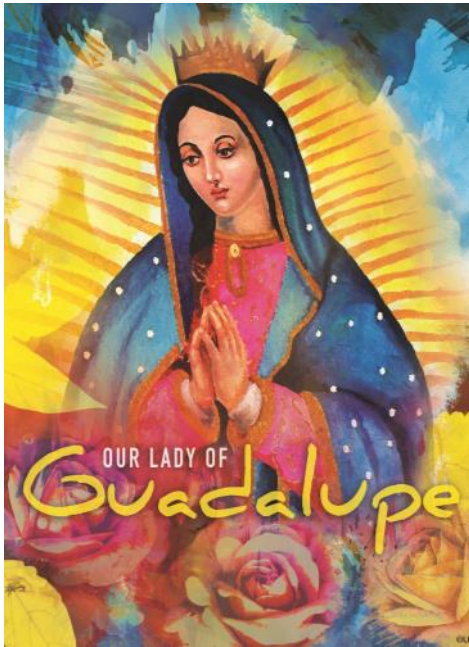

"FULLY ALIVE AS MISSIONARY DISCIPLES"

JOS 5:9A, 10-12/2 COR 5:17-21 / LK 15:1-3, 11-32

Today we read the parable of the prodigal son -- a familiar story to most of us. We have learned to study the three main characters in the story: the unconditionally forgiving father, the righteous older son, and the sinful younger son. Chances are, each time we read this story, we find that we relate to a different character. But let's consider this story from a stewardship perspective. The younger son took all the gifts he was given and spent them selfishly and sinfully. He thought he was living life to the fullest, but quickly found that to be untrue. The older son protected the gifts he received out of obedient devotion to his father but, in the end, he seems to resent doing so. Only the father in this story gives recklessly. He gives abundantly of himself, knowing how each son will react to the gifts, and he forgives in incredible proportions when the boys realize their mistakes. Only the father in this parable is FULLY ALIVE. It is he who disciples his sons and it is he whom we should emulate each day of our lives. Being FULLY ALIVE means receiving the gifts we've been given and sharing them in incredible proportions!!
