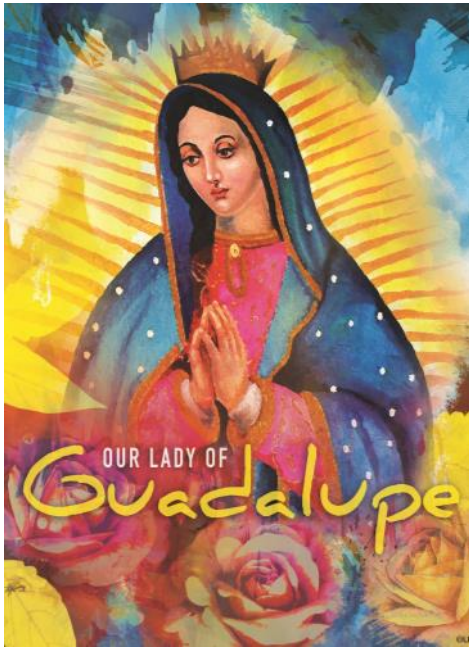

**"FULLY ALIVE AS MISSIONARY DISCIPLES"  
PALM SUNDAY**

IS 50:4-7 / PHIL 2:6-11 / LK 22:14-23:56

On this Palm Sunday, you may find it easy feel a bit of sadness or anger or despair as you read the passion according to Luke. It is, after all, a grim story. For the Jewish people, it was even a story of disappointment, as they really hoped that this Jesus would be "the one." Thankfully, as Christian disciples, we know that the story does not end there -- that this is a story of resurrection and hope! Take a moment to reflect on today's reading from Philipians, where Jesus is shown in great glory! "He emptied himself, taking the form of a slave....he humbled himself, becoming obedient to the point of death....God greatly exalted him and bestowed on him the name which is above every name....Jesus Christ is Lord." Jesus shows us that to be FULLY ALIVE means to surrender yourself completely to God's will! It may not be pretty. It may not please others. It may not be what you had in mind. As disciples, we are called to put our selfish desires aside and place ourselves in the Potter's hands, allowing Him to mold us as He wills. As we enter into Holy Week, let us remember that we are called to holiness, which can only be achieved through surrender.
