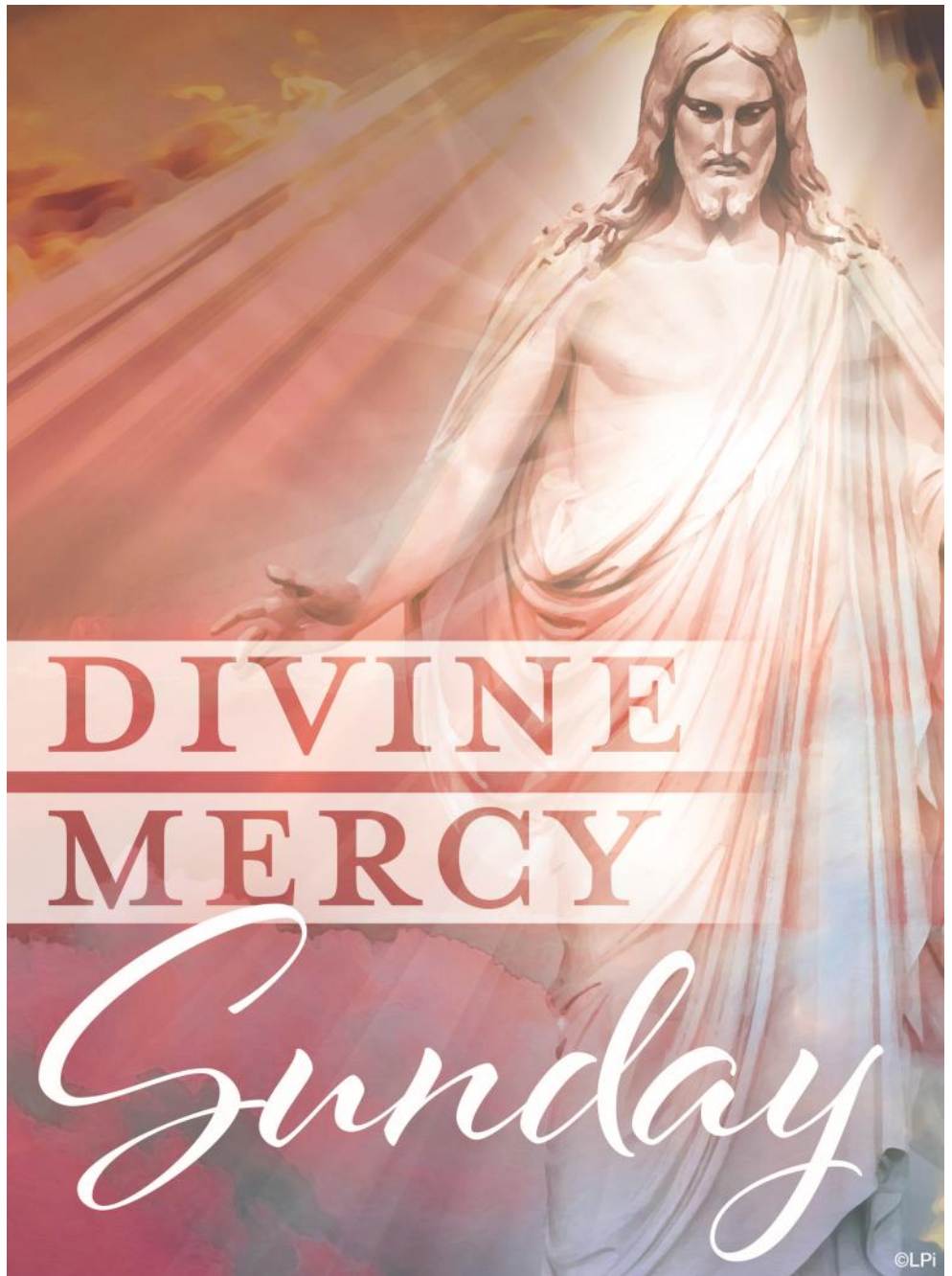

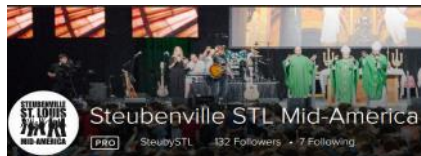

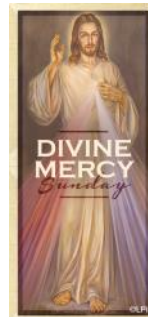


FANTASTIC SPIRITUAL AND FUN OPPORTUNITY FOR OUR HIGH SCHOOL YOUTH.

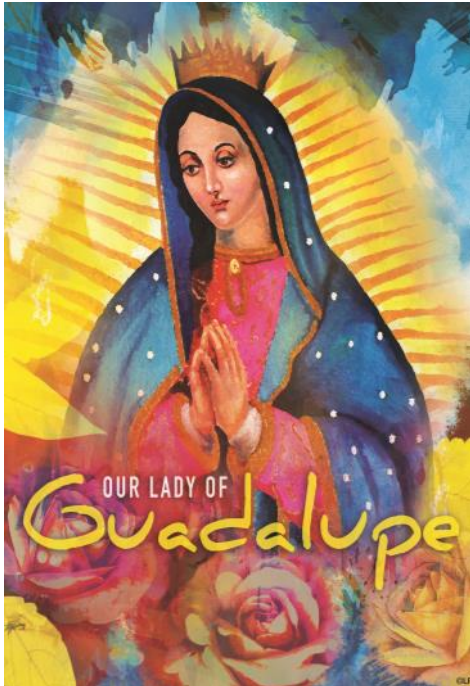

“PLENAMENTE VIVOS COMO DISCÍPULOS MISIONEROS” DOMINGO DE LA DIVINA MISERICORDIA

Nosotros somos personas de Pascua. Vivimos en la edad del Cristo Resucitado y estamos bautizados dentro de la fe que nos llama al Stewardship y la evangelización. En la lectura de hoy de los Hechos de los Apóstoles vemos otra vez a la “gente de Pascua” en acción. Ellos continuaron llevando la buena nueva Ellos se preocupaban por los demás; ellos curaban al enfermo; ellos arrojaron espíritus malos. En pocas palabras, ellos continuaron el trabajo que Jesús empezó. Tu y yo estamos llamados a la misma misión, pero sería sabio recordar otra historia; la historia del niño con el espíritu maligno en Marcos 9,14 -19. En esta lectura, la cual sucedió antes de la resurrección, los discípulos no pudieron arrojar a los demonios que poseían al niño y tuvieron que pedirle ayuda a Jesús. Cuando los discípulos preguntaron porque ellos no tuvieron éxito, Jesús les explicó que este tipo de demonio solo podría salir con la oración. Como discípulos misioneros, DEBEMOS recordar que nosotros no actuamos por nuestra propia cuenta, sino que actuamos de acuerdo a los designios de Dios. Nosotros cooperamos con Sus planes y debemos incluir la oración y el ayuno mientras lo hacemos. Si queremos continuar viviendo como Gente de Pascua, entonces siempre debemos de trabajar en conjunto con el que nos comisionó a hacerlo.

"FULLY ALIVE AS MISSIONARY DISCIPLES"

Divine Mercy Sunday

Acts 5:12-16/Rev 1:9-11A, 12-13, 17-19 / Jn 20: 19-31

We are an Easter People! We live in the age of the Resurrected Christ and we are baptized into a faith that calls us into stewardship and evangelization. In today's reading from the Acts of the Apostles, we see the earliest "Easter People" in action. They continued to spread the good news. They cared for one another; they cured the sick; they cast out unclean spirits. In short, they continued the work begun by Jesus. You and I are called into the same mission, but we would be wise to remember another story...the story of the boy with the evil spirit in Mk 9: 14-29. In this passage, which actually took place before the resurrection, the disciples were unable to cast out the boy's demons, and they had to call on the help of Jesus. When the disciples asked why they were unsuccessful, Jesus explained that this kind of demon can only come out by prayer. As missionary disciples, we MUST remember that we do not act of our own accord; we act in accordance with the will of God. We cooperate with His plans and we must include prayer and fasting as we do so. If we are to continue living as an Easter People, then we must always work in conjunction with the one who commissioned us to do so!
