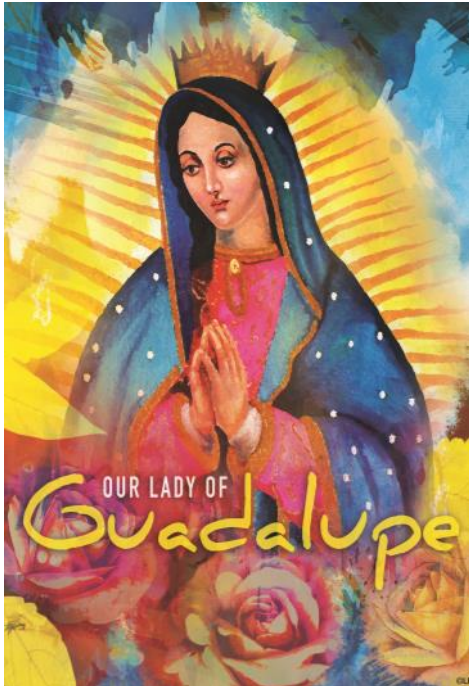

**TERCER DOMINGO DE PASCUA  
HECHOS 5:27-32, 40B-41,  
REV 5:11-14, JN 21:1-19**

Desde el comienzo del cristianismo, los discípulos de Jesús han sido perseguidos por compartir sus creencias. En el transcurso de 2000 años, esas persecuciones han tomado diferentes formas. En la lectura de los hechos de hoy, vemos órdenes directas de los funcionarios gobernantes y líderes judíos que intentan clausurar el caos tras la muerte de Jesús. Los apóstoles, sin embargo, no fueron inmutos. De hecho, hechos 5:41 dice que estos primeros discípulos misioneros "dejaron la presencia del sanedrín, regocijándose de que habían sido encontrados dignos de sufrir deshonra por el bien del nombre." Si bien hay muchos lugares en el mundo que aún castigan a los cristianos con violencia, tenemos la suerte de que nuestro país nos permita la libertad de adorar a nuestro favor, pero esto no significa que no estemos también perseguidos por esas creencias. Lamentablemente, es la propia cultura la que a menudo trata de sofocar el mensaje cristiano. Frente a los medios de comunicación, las aplicaciones sociales y las "noticias falsas", puede ser intimidante levantarse y proclamar el Evangelio. Los cristianos son a menudo avergonzados en silencio. ¡ Es hora de que Reveamos el ejemplo establecido por los apóstoles! Hemos sido bautizados en la misma comunidad cristiana que ellos fueron, y se nos ha dado la misma misión que ellos fueron: ¡ vayan y hagan discípulos de todas las Naciones! Recordemos nuestra llamada al discipulado y estemos dispuestos a "sufrir deshonra por el bien del nombre."

**"FULLY ALIVE AS MISSIONARY DISCIPLES"**

**THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER**

**ACTS 5:27-32, 40B-41, REV 5:11-14 , JN 21: 1-19**

Since the beginning of Christianity, Jesus' disciples have been persecuted for sharing their beliefs. Over the course of two thousand years, those persecutions have taken on different forms. In today's reading from Acts, we see direct orders from the governing officials and Jewish leaders that attempt to shut down the chaos in the wake of Jesus' death. The apostles, however, were undeterred. In fact, Acts 5:41 says that these earliest missionary disciples "left the presence of the Sanhedrin, rejoicing that they had been found worthy to suffer dishonor for the sake of the name." While there are many places in the world that still punish Christians with violence, we are fortunate that our country allows us the freedom to worship as we please, but this does not mean that we are not also persecuted for those beliefs. Sadly, it is the culture itself that often tries to stifle the Christian message. In the face of the media, social apps, and "fake news," it can be intimidating to stand up and proclaim the Gospel. Christians are often shamed into silence. It is time for us to look again at the example set by the apostles! We have been baptized into the same Christian community that they were, and we have been given the same mission that they were: go and make disciples of all nations! Let us remember our call to discipleship and be willing to "suffer dishonor for the sake of the name."
