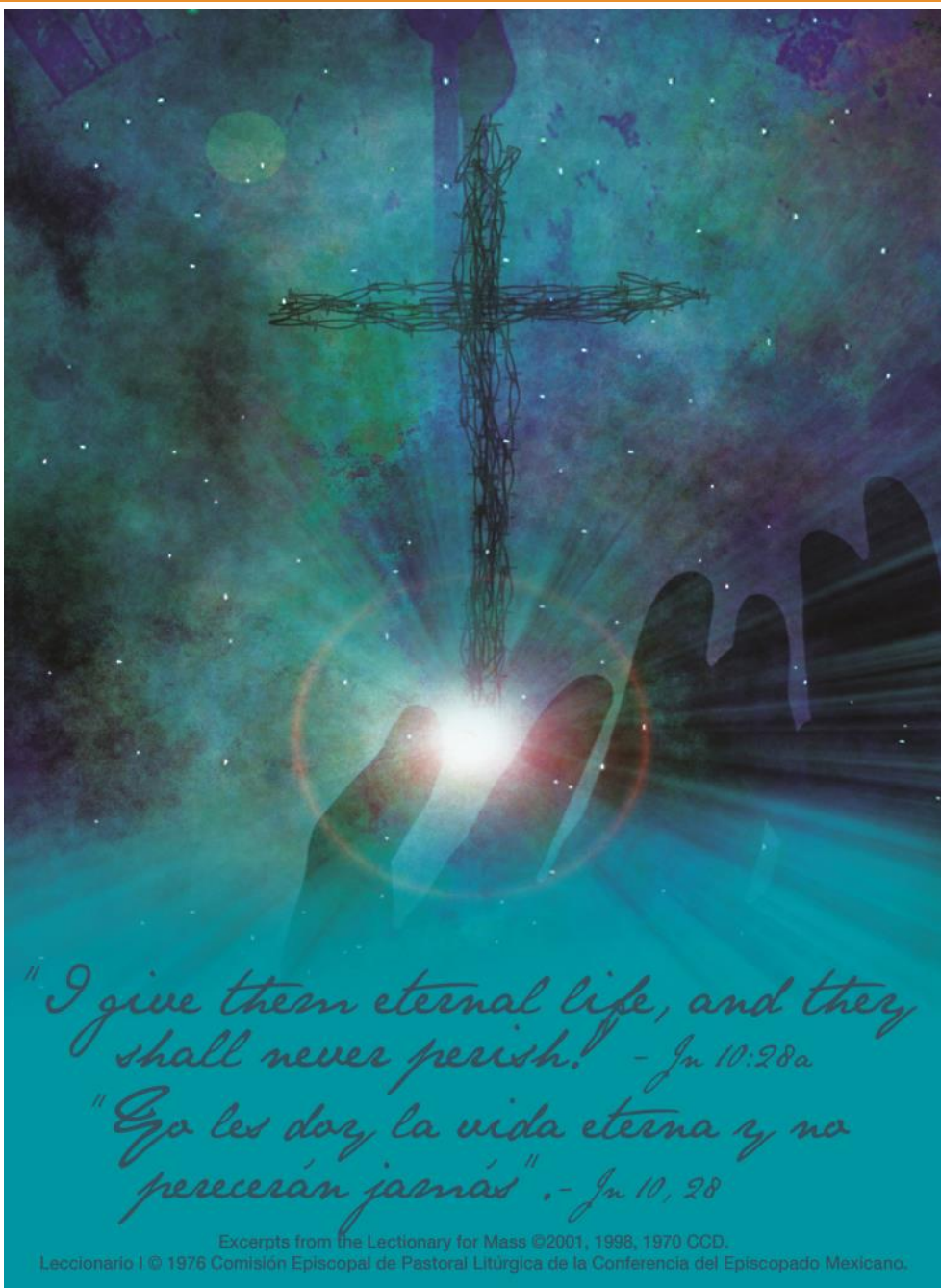

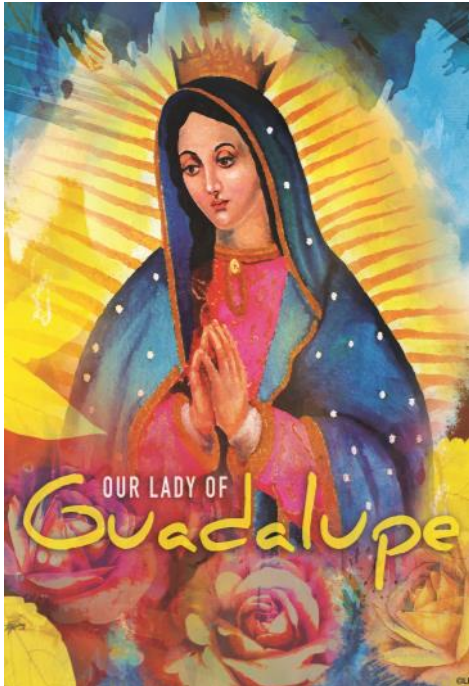

HECHOS 13:14, 43-52, REV 7: 9, 14B-17, JN 10: 27-30

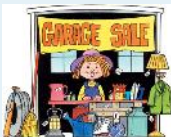
La breve lectura de hoy del Evangelio de Juan llega directamente al corazón del discipulado. Un discípulo es un seguidor y debe saber quién y qué está siguiendo. Jesús dice: "Mis ovejas oyen mi voz; Los conozco y ellos me siguen". ¿Qué partes de tus rutinas diarias te permiten escuchar y conocer la voz de tu pastor? ¿Pasas tiempo leyendo las escrituras? ¿Buscas su voz en tu silencioso tiempo de oración? Nuestro mundo es ruidoso, y tenemos que ser intencionales para despejar el desorden y seguir la voz que nos promete la vida eterna. Como las ovejas, los humanos tienden a funcionar mejor en grupos. ¿Tal vez necesita un pequeño grupo de discipulado que lo ayude a mantenerse al alcance de la voz del Pastor? Puedes intentar un estudio de la Biblia o un grupo de oración. ¡Busque oportunidades a lo largo de su día cuando pueda registrarse con el Buen Pastor! ¡No puedes seguir una voz que no puedes escuchar!

"FULLY ALIVE AS MISSIONARY DISCIPLES"

Fourth Sunday of Easter

Acts 13:14, 43-52, Rev 7:9, 14B-17, Jn 10:27-30

Today's brief reading from the Gospel of John gets straight to the heart of discipleship. A disciple is a follower and must know who and what he is following. Jesus says, "My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me." What parts of your daily routines allow you to hear and know the voice of your shepherd? Do you spend time reading scripture? Do you seek his voice in your quiet prayer time? Our world is a noisy one, and we have to be intentional about clearing out the clutter and following the voice that promises us eternal life. Like sheep, humans tend to function best in groups. Perhaps you need a small discipleship group to help you stay in range of the Shepherd's voice? You might try a Bible study or a prayer group. Look for opportunities throughout your day when you can check in with the Good Shepherd! You can't follow a voice you can't hear!
