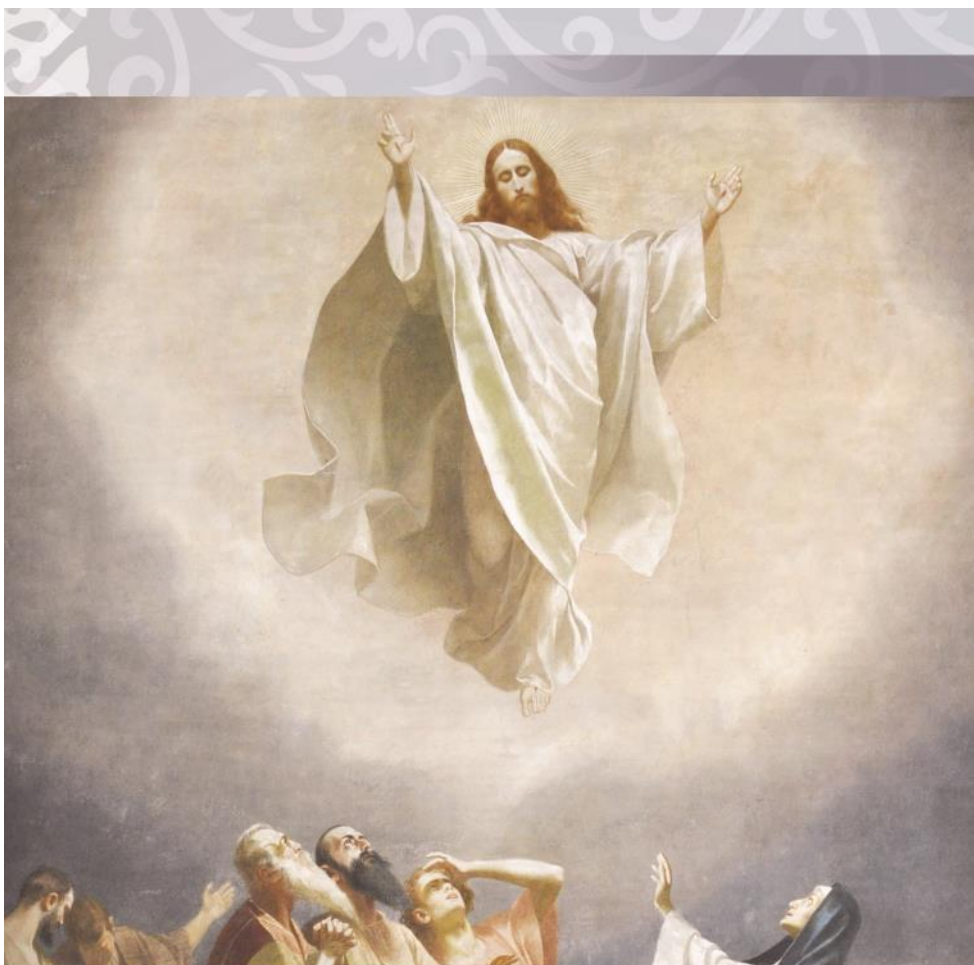

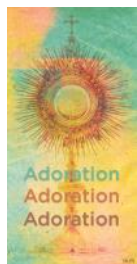

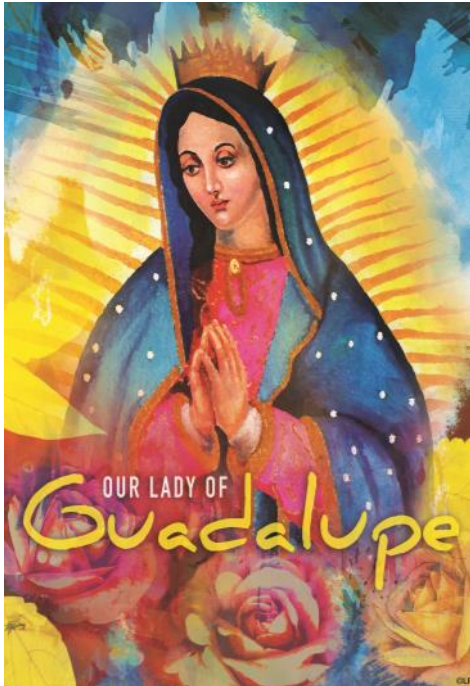

DISCÍPULOS MISIONEROS "**
LA ASCENSIÓN DEL SEÑOR
HECHOS 1:1-11, EF 1:17-23, LC
24:46-53

Hechos 1:5: "... para Juan bautizado con agua, pero en pocos días serás bautizado con el Espíritu Santo. " Este versículo de la primera lectura podría hacernos hacer una pausa y considerar la diferencia entre los dos tipos de bautismo. ¿Es uno inferior al otro? La palabra bautismo proviene de una palabra griega que significa "sumergirse." Juan predicó un mensaje de arrepentimiento, y su bautismo — una inmersión en el agua — era una marca externa de ese arrepentimiento. Jesús, sin embargo, habló de un bautismo en el Espíritu Santo, uno que sumerge a la gente más profundamente en el Reino de Dios. Cuando reflexionemos sobre nuestro propio bautismo, debemos considerar ambos aspectos: el agua como signo del arrepentimiento y del espíritu, que nos obliga a conocer y proclamar el Reino de Dios. Como cristianos bautizados, ciertamente estamos plenamente vivos, pero debemos elegir conscientemente ser discípulos misioneros. Como Jesús, debemos permitir que nuestro bautismo abra nuestros corazones y nuestras mentes a la voluntad de Dios. Un buen mayordomo significa cooperar con su voluntad.

The Ascension of the Lord

Acts 1:1-11, Eph 1:17-23, Lk 24:46-53

Acts 1:5: "...for John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit." This verse from the first reading might cause us to take pause and consider the difference between the two kinds of baptism. Is one inferior to the other? The word baptism comes from a Greek word meaning "to immerse." John preached a message of repentance, and his baptism — an immersion in water — was an outward mark of that repentance. Jesus, however, spoke of a baptism in the Holy Spirit, one that plunges people deeper into the Kingdom of God. When we reflect on our own baptism, we must consider both aspects: the water as a sign of repentance and the Spirit, which compels us to know and proclaim the Kingdom of God. As baptized Christians, we are certainly Fully Alive, but we must consciously choose to be Missionary Disciples. Like Jesus, we have to allow our baptism to open our hearts and our minds to God's will. A good steward means cooperating with His will.
