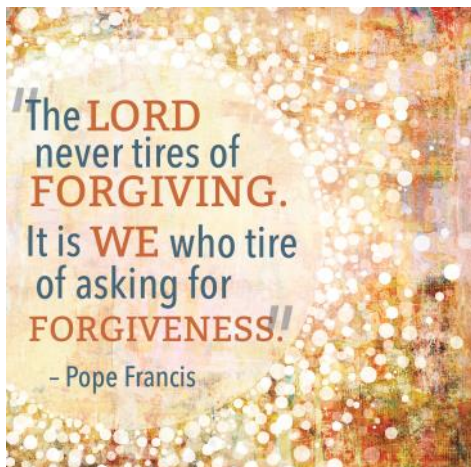

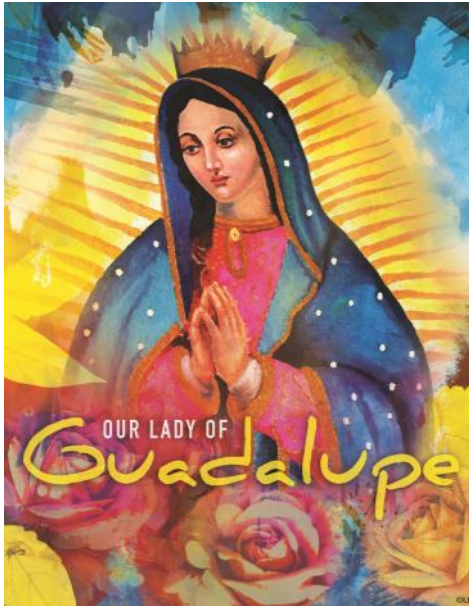

**HOLA MI NOMBRE ES FATHER**

**CHARLES SEIWERT**, por favor me de llamarme "Padre Carlos." Soy el nuevo párroco. Ordenado en 1999 para la Diócesis de Wichita, he servido en varias parroquias adentro y fuera de la diócesis. Lo más reciente, vengo de Santa María en Garden City, Kansas al ser en servicio a la Diócesis de Dodge City desde 2011. Antes de eso, fui párroco de Sagrado Corazón en Arkansas City por seis años. Estoy muy a gusto estar aquí en Nuestra Señora – tenemos una parroquia muy linda que refleje yo creo muy bien la ciudad de Hutchinson. Con un poco de tiempo estaré involucrado hasta cierto punto en todas actividades de la parroquia. Tal vez hare unos cambios inmediatamente, pero por lo general, yo quisiera consultar con gente antes de hacer cambios grandes en las prácticas de la comunidad. Próxima junta de consejo pastoral es 16 de julio, 7:30 pm en salón parroquial.

**"FULLY ALIVE AS MISSIONARY DISCIPLES"**

DEUT 30:10-14, COL 1:15-20, LK 10: 25-37

In today's first reading, Moses explains that discipleship and obedience to God's commandments are the most natural behaviors for us — "it is already in your mouths and in your hearts; you only have to carry it out." In the gospel, Jesus uses a parable to drive this point home when he is questioned by "a scholar of the law." The young scholar clearly understands the law as it is written, but questions Jesus on who, exactly, his neighbor is. After listening to the parable, the scholar has no problem understanding that a neighborly person is one who shows love. In fact, the answer was already in his heart, he simply needs to carry it out, as Moses said! This week, reflect on the reading from Deuteronomy. Discipleship is not too mysterious and remote for you. It is not out of reach, up in the sky or across the sea. It is already in your heart, and has been since your baptism. You only have to carry it out.

**EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP**

What does it mean to give of yourself completely, without reservation, without fear, and without a concern for the cost? Should it matter if the person who needs us is unlike us in skin color, religion, or nationality? What does real mercy look like? Jesus answered these questions beautifully in perhaps the greatest of the stewardship parables, the story of the Good Samaritan. Here a Judean traveler has been attacked, beaten, and left for dead on the side of the road. Others see him, but the cost to them to stop and help is too great. It is a Samaritan, one who is despised by most in the area, that stops, and he gives of his time, talent, and treasure to help the poor victim. Where the Samaritan was going we cannot know for sure, but he stopped to give his time to the beaten man. Using oil and wine, he bandaged the wounds. Not everyone has the knowledge and skills to care for someone in this manner. Here, he gave of his talent. Then he placed the man on his own animal and carried him to an inn the rest of the day. The following day he pays the innkeeper, yet leaves explaining that if the payment is not enough, when he travels back on through he will repay him whatever the cost. Of course, here he shares his treasure. The sharing of these things is profound enough, but it is the statement of his willingness to pay whatever the balance is that elevates this tale to an ultimate example of stewardship. The Samaritan does not care how high the cost. He will give whatever is needed. This is mature discipleship, to respond to the call of Jesus Christ regardless of the cost. This is true stewardship.

**"PLENAMENTE VIVO COMO DISCÍPULOS MISIONEROS "**

En la primera lectura de hoy, Moisés explica que su discipulado y obediencia a los mandamientos de Dios son nuestros comportamientos más naturales; "de hecho ya están en sus bocas y en sus corazones, solo lo tienen que llevar a cabo." En el Evangelio, Jesús usa la parábola para llegar a este punto, cuando es cuestionado por un "erudito en la ley". El joven erudito claramente entiende la ley como está escrita, pero cuestiona a Jesús acerca de quien exactamente su prójimo es. Mientras escucha la parábola, el erudito no tiene problemas en entender que un prójimo es una persona que demuestra amor. De hecho esta respuesta ya estaba dentro de su corazón y él solamente necesitaba dejarla salir así como Moisés había dicho. Esta semana reflexionen acerca de la lectura de Deuteronomio. El discipulado no es tan misterioso ni es tan lejano para ustedes; este no está fuera del alcance, ni se encuentra en el cielo ni al cruzar del océano. Este ya se encuentra en sus corazones y siempre ha estado allí desde sus bautismos. Solo tienen que dejarlo salir y llevarlo a cabo.
