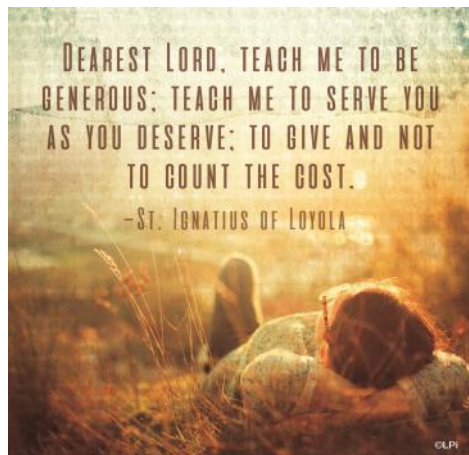

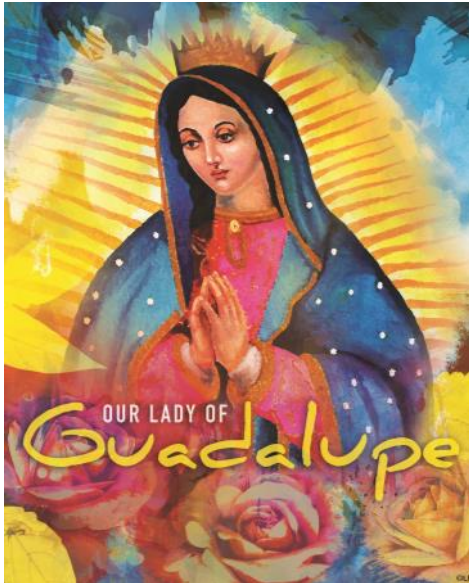

**"PLENAMENTE VIVO COMO  
DISCÍPULOS MISIONEROS "**

La Oración, uno de los Pilares del Stewardship debe de ser una parte integral de nuestras vidas como discípulos misioneros. Esta es la única manera en la que verdaderamente podemos tener una relación íntima con Dios y es la única forma en la que podemos realmente cooperar con Sus planes para nuestras vidas. Desafortunadamente, muchos de nosotros no tomamos el tiempo de orar y por eso nuestras vidas de Stewardship está un poco dañada. Jesús aclara que nuestras oraciones deben de ser constantes, persistentes y que solo así recibiremos la respuesta de Dios que será amorosa y buena. Si aún no tienen un hábito de oración diaria, sigan el ejemplo de Jesús. Él siempre tiene un lugar particular para la oración (muchas veces siendo este una montaña) y un método simple para orar. Tristemente, Kansas no cuenta con muchas oportunidades para orar en lo alto de una montaña pero hay otras muchas opciones. Tu Iglesia o su capilla de adoración pueden ser lugares maravillosos para empezar este hábito. También sería bueno establecer un lugar de oración en sus hogares; tal vez un cuarto callado con una silla confortable y una mesa donde poner su Rosario, estatuas o símbolos y/o libros de oración—algo simple. Entonces, también escojan una hora (u horas) del día cuando puedan ser constantes y puedan desarrollar el hábito. Esta dicho que la oración cambia al orador(a). Dejen hacerse plenamente vivos desarrollando este aspecto de su Stewardship.

**DEAR PARISHIONERS:**

I've nearly completed 30 days here at Our Lady of Guadalupe. I am pleased so far. I'm happy to have met with key groups of the parish: Finance Council, Parish Pastoral Council, Stewardship Committee. Additionally, I've met with social groups: Altar Society, Emmaus Women, and by now hopefully CHRHP.

This weekend I'm having opportunity to meet parents of our Catholic school children. Thank you, parents, for making time in your schedule to come to our meeting. I want to let you know that Parish School of Religion (PSR) and our Catholic School Ministry (Holy Cross & Trinity) occupy the highest priority in parish life. The R.C.I.A. program also beckons our attention; this has equal weighting with PSR.

State Fair activities of our parish require my attention. I am asking parent(s) of Catholic school children to donate 12 hours yearly of their volunteerism time to Our Lady of Guadalupe activities. I recommend that our school families donate their time to State Fair activities. I'll explain a bit more in coming days.

**"FULLY ALIVE AS MISSIONARY DISCIPLES"  
SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME  
GEN 18:20-32, COL 2:12-14, LK 11:1-13**

Prayer, one of the four Pillars of Stewardship, should be an integral part of our lives as missionary disciples. It is the only way we can truly have an intimate relationship with God, and it is the only way we can really cooperate with His plans for our lives. Unfortunately, many of us don't take the time to pray and therefore our life of stewardship is somewhat crippled. Jesus makes it clear that our prayers should be constant and persistent, and we should expect God's response to be loving and kind. If you do not have a habit of daily prayer, look to Jesus for an example. He has a particular place for prayer (often upon a mountain!) and a simple method of prayer. Sadly, Kansas doesn't offer many mountaintop prayer opportunities, but there are lots of other options! Your church or its adoration chapel might be wonderful places to start. It would also be good to establish a prayer place in your home. A quiet room or a comfy chair with a table where you can keep your rosary, statues or icons, and/or prayer books will work — keep it simple! Then choose a time (or times!) of day that you can keep consistent and develop the habit. It is said that prayer changes the pray-er! Allow yourself to become fully alive by developing this aspect of your stewardship!
