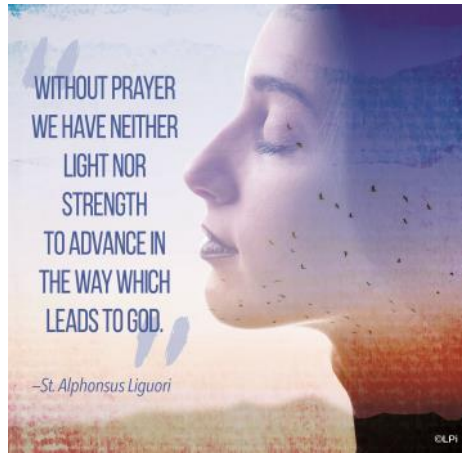

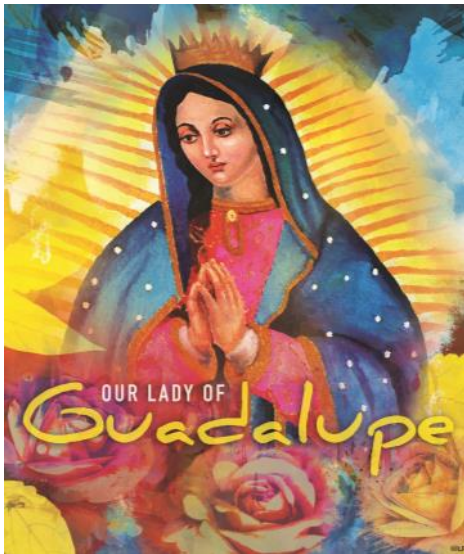

"FULLY ALIVE AS MISSIONARY DISCIPLES"

Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time
 Ecc 1:2, 2:21-23, Col 3:1-5, 9-11, Lk 12:13-21

When we look at today's readings, we see examples of the anti-stewardship mindset. In the first reading, we have Qoheleth, who basically minimizes the value of life to his wealth and possessions, of which he has none. His tone is somewhat resentful that for all his hard work, he has nothing to show for it at the end of his life. Then in the Gospel, Jesus has to point out possessions are not the indicator of a "rich" life, and that we should "take care to guard against all greed." Being a good steward means showing gratitude by sharing our blessings and using them to enrich the lives of one another. It does not mean building bigger barns to store the gifts we have been given. This applies not only to our wealth and possessions, but to every aspect of our lives as disciples. Let us open our minds and hearts to our call to stewardship!

"PLENAMENTE VIVO COMO DISCÍPULOS MISIONEROS "

Si ponemos atención a las lecturas de hoy, podemos ver ejemplos de un pensamiento anti-stewardship. En la primera lectura tenemos a Qoheleth, quien básicamente minimiza el valor de la vida de acuerdo a las posesiones y a la riqueza, de las cuales no tiene ninguna. La forma en que se expresa, tiene un tono poco resentido porque, aunque ha trabajado arduamente, él no tiene nada que refleje ese esfuerzo al final de su vida. Después, en el Evangelio Jesús tiene que indicarnos que las posesiones materiales no son indicadores de una vida "rica" y que deberíamos "Cuidar y salvaguardarnos de toda avaricia." Ser un buen practicante del stewardship significa mostrar gratitud compartiendo nuestras bendiciones y usándolas para enriquecer las vidas de todos nosotros. Esto no significa el edificar almacenes más grandes para guardar los regalos que hemos recibido; esto aplica no solo a nuestra riqueza y posesiones, sino también cada aspecto de nuestras vidas como discípulos. Abramos nuestras mentes y corazones al llamado que nos hace el stewardship.



18º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario
 Seguimos avanzando en la enseñanza del Evangelio de Lucas.

Poco a poco nos lleva hacia Jerusalén y Jesús proclama el Reino de Dios con sus enseñanzas y curaciones. Vale que recordemos la frase tan repetida en muchas ocasiones para nosotros: "Donde está tu tesoro, allí estará también tu corazón." (Lucas 12:34). La vida no nos impide el poseer, sino el no saber compartir lo que Dios, con su infinita misericordia, nos da por medio de nuestro trabajo cotidiano. A lo largo de la existencia, esta ha sido la lucha del ser humano que acumula tanto que no haya donde ponerlo. Hace planes, proyectos y sueños pensando que vivirá en esta tierra para siempre. Sin embargo, no es así. Mira lo que dice el ejemplo de este domingo: "¡Pobre loco! Esta misma noche te reclaman tu alma. ¿Quién se quedará con lo que has preparado?" (Lucas 12:20). Hoy reflexionemos en lo importante de la experiencia humana. Con el paso de los años, continuamente tenemos falsas expectativas sobre lo que es la vida. La vida es un suspiro y pasa de prisa. Por lo tanto, debemos pensar que todo lo que vivimos es pasajero y que lo verdadero es acumular para el cielo. No hay que asustarse sino proponerse al cambio girando el corazón a Dios. El reto es ser rico en lo que vale a los ojos de Dios. ¿Cómo? Bueno, comenzando con algo simple: trabajar con honradez, no hacer trampas, ser fieles, tender la mano al que lo necesita sin esperar recompensa por todo. La participación en la Eucaristía nos abre la mente a lo verdadero, que es la sabiduría revelada por Dios.
