WORKERS NEEDED!!

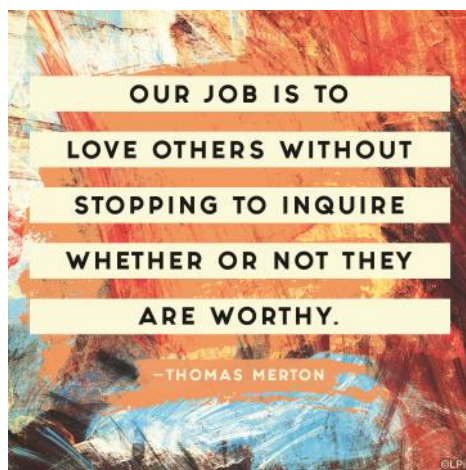

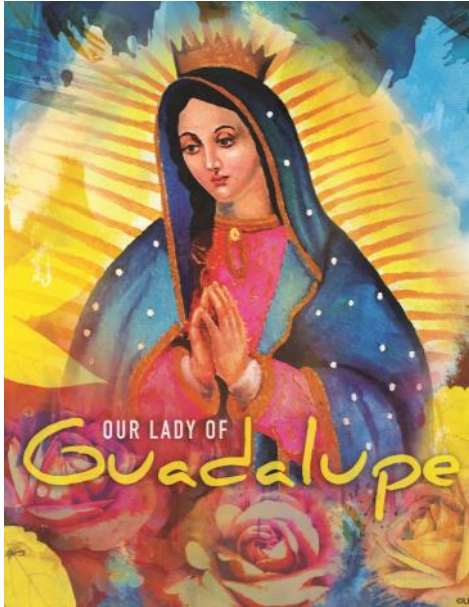

se humune será exaltado." En el Evangelio
de hoy, Jesús se dirige a los fariseos, que
luchan por lugares de honor en la mesa. La
mayoría de nosotros probablemente hemos
sido culpables de este comportamiento
antes— buscando afirmación y dando
atención a las personas de popularidad.
Todos podemos beneficiarnos de la lección
de esta parábola: que sólo en la reducción
de nosotros mismos podemos ser
levantados. San Agustín dijo: "Hay algo en la
humildad que extrañamente exalta el
corazón." Cuando dejamos de ponernos
delante de los demás, finalmente podemos
empezar a vivir una vida de santidad.

"FULLY ALIVE AS MISSIONARY DISCIPLES"

TWENTY-SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

SIR 3:17-18, 20, 28-29, HEB 12:18-19, 22-24A, LK 14:1, 7-14

Our baptism calls us into a life of stewardship, which requires generosity and humility. We have received many gifts, and are asked to use them for the good of one another. We are called to share these gifts with others, be it in the form of money or service, with no expectation of repayment. Additionally, we should not flaunt our wealth or our social status. Rather, Jesus says, "The one who humbles himself will be exalted." In today's Gospel, Jesus addresses the Pharisees, who are contending for places of honor at the table. Most of us have likely been guilty of this behavior before – seeking affirmation and giving undo attention to people of popularity. We can all benefit from the lesson of this parable: that it is only in lowering ourselves that we can be raised up. Saint Augustine said, "There is something in humility which strangely exalts the heart." When we stop putting ourselves before others, we can finally begin living a life of holiness.
